Come check us out in **Booth 1032!** When deploying an IP camera system, one thing that is often overlooked is the Switch. Most IP video devices transmit video via Unicast. Due to the number of Unicast streams a device can transmit, as well as the volume of traffic, a managed layer 2 switch is recommended. The benefits are the additional features it offers, such as IGMP, QoS, and cut-through switching. If a video stream will be viewed by 5 or more clients simultaneously, consider configuring the system for Multicast, which allows the network to replicate the video stream. If using Multicast, ensure your layer 2 switch is IGMP-2

capable and use a managed layer 3 switch with a Multicast Query chip.
