Researchers Developing Cameras to See Around Corners

The Morgridge Institute of Research and the University of Wisconsin-Madison, supported by DARPA, are collaborating to develop a camera capable of recreating scenes that are out of sight. The technology, known as scattered light technology, attempts to use the history of the light's bounces to reconstruct images of objects around a corner. Additionally, researchers hope to determine what other type of information is embedded in the scattered light and what else might be extracted. The 4 year program has two phases, a theoretical foundation and an experimental exploration, and a demonstration will occur upon completion. *Courtesy of NDIA

Over the next year, all Bosch IP cameras (from the IP 4000 family on up), will come fully equipped with video analytics at the edge. This will enable users to stream only what is relevant, retrieve evidence more efficiently, and trigger alarms when needed, minimizing the amount of video being sent to the DVR, thus conserving bandwidth consumption and storage space. Additionally, top of the line series will feature Intelligent Video Analytics, capable of learning behaviors and reducing false alarms.
